

Environmental Policy Statement

Monashee Surveying and Geomatics (**Monashee**) will organize and manage our operations and activities in a manner that demonstrates care and respect for the environment. Our overall goal is to prevent environmental harm in all our activities. We are committed to operating in an environmentally responsible manner and believe that responsible stewardship of both the natural and the built environment is essential for business efficiency and success. We will do this efficiently while meeting or exceeding applicable environmental laws and regulations.

We continually strive to improve our environmental performance and the Environmental Management System described within this Policy Statement is designed to help us achieve this.

The purpose of the Environmental Management System described in this Policy is to:

1. Instruct all individuals at Monashee in the implementation of the policy so they have knowledge and understanding of their own obligations towards meeting the environmental objectives of the organization;
2. To set a policy of commitment to effective environmental management;
3. To inform our clients of the measures we take to ensure that our activities and services have a minimal effect on the environment;
4. Co-ordinate the management of activities concerned with actual and potential environmental impacts;
5. Demonstrate that Monashee has complete awareness of environmental issues and recognize the views of all parties.

Our Commitments:

1. Monashee will, wherever viable and consistent with the Client's instructions, use materials and products from sustainable sources or that are reusable or recyclable.
2. Monashee will make every effort to conserve the use of materials and of energy and, where applicable and consistent with our Client's instructions, collect waste materials for recycling.
3. Monashee will prepare and implement environmental management plans consistent with our environmental policy on individual project sites, and for each site will nominate a competent person to supervise compliance with these instructions, who will normally be the Site Safety Supervisor.

The impact of development on our environment and its physical and natural features is undeniable. Unless otherwise specified by the client, Monashee will provide the products of our work (topographical site surveys, engineering and construction surveys and legal survey plans) in an electronic format wherever possible.

Each employee is empowered and responsible for implementing this policy as it pertains to his or her job. This policy is a guiding document and there is no substitute for sound judgment. Employees are encouraged, and supported, to constructively challenge actions that may cause adverse impacts on the environment. Monashee will stay committed to improving our environment where we work, live, and play.
